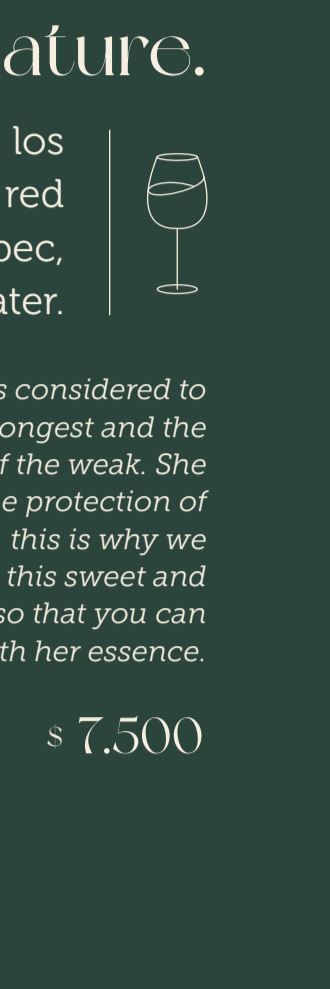

Passionfruit-flavored Sernova vodka, red fruit liquor, lemon and tonic water.

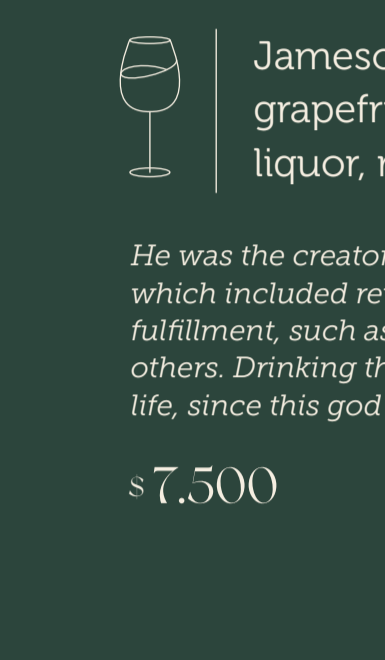

Príncipe de los Apóstoles Gin, red fruit with malbec, lime and tonic water.

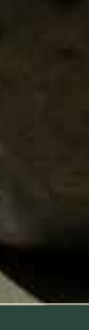

Morpheus

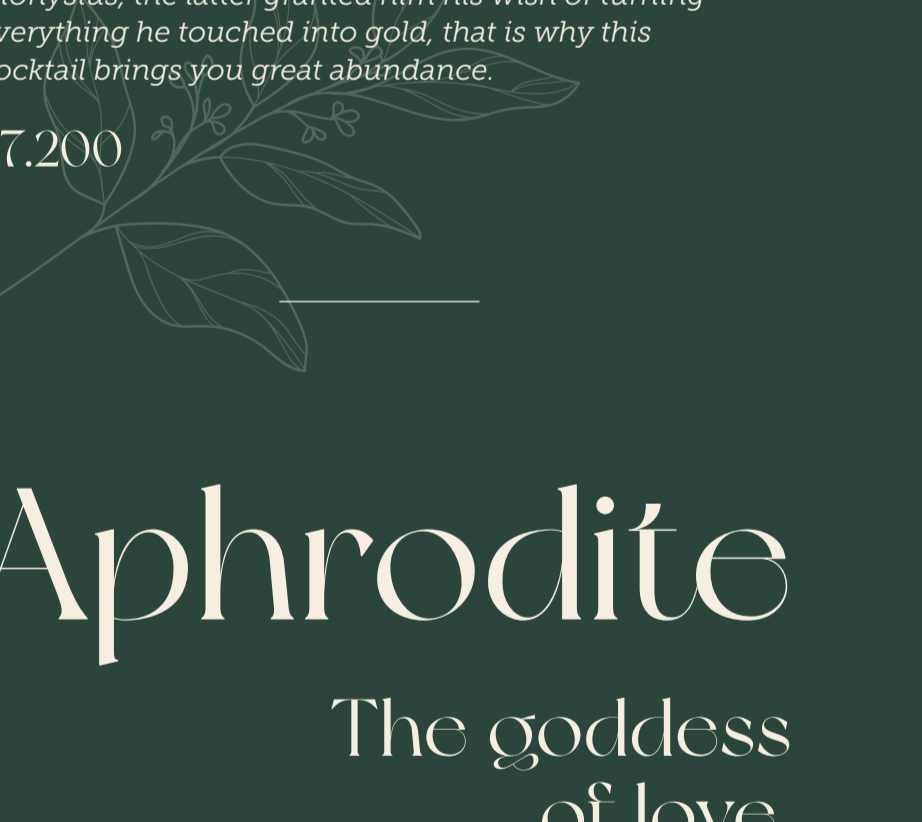
The god of dreams.



Espresso Martini with Gin (Apóstoles Gin, espresso coffee, coffee liqueur, simple syrup)

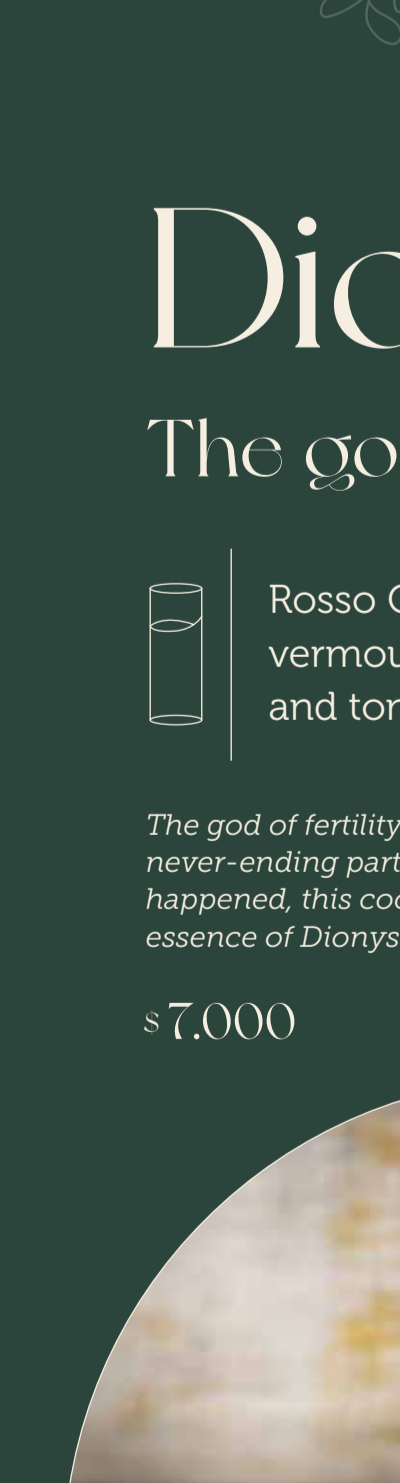

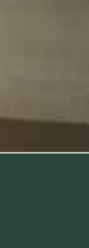

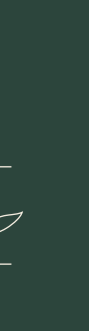


Athenea Spritz
